STL 2030 JOBS PLAN INITIATIVE TRACKER | HIGHLIGHTING METRO INCLUSIVE GROWTH EFFORTS



The [*STL 2030 Jobs Plan*](#) lays out a 10-year roadmap to boost economic growth, increase quality jobs, and reduce racial disparities across the metro. To achieve these goals, STL 2030 Progress aggregates and highlights major net-new public and private efforts that are advancing recommended initiatives. The website's tracking initiatives tool aims to facilitate collaboration and help elected officials, business and civic leaders, funders, and other stakeholders across the region and country gain awareness of the breadth and depth of activities that are underway so that they can better advance regional efforts driving inclusive growth.

WHAT'S INCLUDED IN THE TRACKER?

The Tracker captures summary-level information on major projects, programs, and efforts launched since the release of the *STL 2030 Jobs Plan* in May 2021. At this time, the Initiatives Tracker does not capture ongoing or steady-state programs and funding sources that were fully established prior to 2021, although we recognize the critical importance of such sustaining efforts. Each of the entries includes the following fields: overview, implementation status, goals, next steps, lead and collaborating organizations, cost, funding status, as well as ties to the Metrics Focus Areas and *STL 2030 Jobs Plan* Core Priorities.

In addition to highlighting legacy strength and emerging St. Louis industry clusters, the *STL 2030 Jobs Plan* called for implementation of 19 priority initiatives across five Actionable Strategies. Upon its initial release in September 2023, the Initiatives Tracker captures 200+ entries across these initiatives.

- Expand transit and digital access to better connect St. Louisans to opportunities no matter where they live.
